Shake and Spill!

How to play:

- 1. Select between 5 and 20 small objects such as cheerios or small pieces of Lego.
- 2. Count them to make sure you know how many there are.
- 3. Put them in a cup.
- 4. Pour them onto the image of the bucket. Some will land inside the bucket and some will not.
- 5. In your journal, draw or write numbers to show what landed in the bucket and what spilled outside!
- 6. Try again! How many ways can you shake and spill?

Teacher Tip:


- Put the printout into a plastic pocket to protect it.
- Put the protected printout into the bottom of a container so that the pieces don't spill onto the floor.

Extensions:

- 1. If you count what is in the bucket, can you figure out what fell outside the bucket without counting?
- 2. Can you write an equation? In the bucket + outside the bucket = total?
- 3. Play with 5 or ten. Can you graph the combinations? Which combination will win? Graphing printout on page 3 and 4.
